## BE PREPARED

If you attend a FAFSA help session, be sure to come prepared. You will need the following:

- Social Security Number, for parent and student.
- Driver's license number for parent and student (if applicable).
- Alien registration number, for non-U.S. citizens.
- Copy of most recent year's Federal Income Tax Return.\*
- 2009 W-2 forms and other records of money earned, for parent and student.
- 2009 untaxed income records, including income from social security, welfare TANF or veteran's benefits for parent and student.
- Information on savings, investments and business assets for parent and student.





# FAFSA AND TAX HELP— ALL IN ONE

In partnership with H&R Block and Baltimore CASH Campaign, City Schools is providing families with tax return and FAFSA help at the same time, and for income-eligible families, the tax help is free. Financial aid counselors will also be on hand to guide you in the actual financial aid application process, once your FAFSA is complete.
