## PARENT AGREEMENT

As a Parent or Guardian of an MTA eligible 6<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> grade student of Baltimore City Public Schools:

I allow my child who is in K-5 grade, and 8 years old or older, to use the MTA One Card only while accompanied by their older sibling who is in the grade 6 through 12, as a means to get to and from school and school related activities, as approved by my child's principal.

As a parent/guardian of a Baltimore City Public School's student, I understand that

- Students can only use the One Card to get to and from school and school related activities.

- My children cannot use their One Card during school hours, except for school-approved activities.
- The One Card is active for four 120 minute travel windows on school days between the hours of 5 a.m. and 8 p.m.
- I understand to replace a lost MTA One Card costs \$5.00.

I understand that the One Card is the property of City Schools and I am aware that City Schools and my child's principal can track One Card use at any time, with or without notice. I acknowledge that I have no expectations as to privacy or confidentiality as it relates to my child's One Card usage.

I understand that if I fail to comply with this Acceptable Use of MTA One Card, my child's MTA One Card privileges can be terminated.
