I. DIRECTIVE

It is the policy of the Baltimore City School Police Force (BCSPF) to comply with the Maryland Annotated Code, Public Safety Article, §3-301 et. seq. collectively known as the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights (LEOBOR)

II. PURPOSE

The purpose of this directive is to provide a reference of the uniform procedures to be employed in the handling of situations involving law enforcement officers under investigation as a result of disciplinary-type complaints lodged against the law enforcement member, from either within or outside the agency.

III. GENERAL

BCSPF shall comply with Maryland Annotated Code, Public Safety Article, §3-301 et. seq., collectively known as the Law Enforcement Officers' Bill of Rights (LEOBR).

This Order shall be effective on the date of publication.
