Maryland law requires that students be fully immunized against certain infectious diseases to attend school. If you have questions about your child's immunizations or she or he needs updated immunizations, contact your child's doctor or visit a Health Department clinic. If your child's school has a health center, the staff there can also help you with immunizations.
