What do I have to do to complete this course?

This four-course sequence includes classroom instruction as well as formal training at selected local fire companies. Students are required to complete a minimum of 393 hours of work-based learning and take the seven certification exams. This CTE pathway program is designed to allow students to complete all requirements and be certified in this area as well as have opportunities to earn college credit..
